These large-fruited persimmons are comprised of various cultivars of the species *Diospyros kaki*. As with the hybrid situation with mulberries (*Morus spp.*) and the numerous species of blackberries and dewberries (*Rubus spp.*) and blueberries (*Vaccinium spp.*), most observers are not capable of separating involved plants into species designations. **Observed:** Ruby-throated Hummingbird, **Rufous Hummingbird*, Blue Jay, Fish Crow, N. Hawthorn spp. (*Crataegus spp.*) – Numerous species in Louisiana. Parsley Hawthorn (*C. marshallii*) and Mayhaw (*C. aestivalis/opaca*) are the most commonly known/planted. Green Hawthorn (*C. viridis; aka "hog haw"*) is the most commonly encountered species in bottomland hardwood settings. **Observed:** *Red-bellied Woodpecker*, Least Flycatcher, Hermit Thrush, Am. Robin, *E. Bluebird*, Gray Catbird, *N. Mockingbird*, *Ruby-crowned Kinglet*, White-throated Sparrow, N. Cardinal.

*Wild/Indian Strawberry (Duchesnea spp.) – Refers to one or more exotic species distributed across many habitat types and landscapes in Louisiana. **Observed:** White-winged Dove.

Loquat/Japanese Plum (Eriobotrya japonica) – **Observed:** Red-bellied Woodpecker, Downy Woodpecker, Blue Jay, Am. Crow, Fish Crow, Gray Catbird, N. Mockingbird, Cedar Waxwing, House Finch, Rose-breasted Grosbeak, Indigo Bunting, Orchard Oriole, Baltimore Oriole.

Red-tip Photinia (*Photinia glabra*) – **Observed:** Cedar Waxwing.

*Dewberry/Blackberry (Rubus spp.) – Many species in Louisiana, wild and cultivated. Family Rubiaceae

Firebush (*Hamelia patens*) – **Observed:** Blue Jay, N. Mockingbird, N. Cardinal.

Family Rutaceae

Prickly Ash (*Zanthoxylum clava-herculis; aka "Toothache Tree"*) – **Observed:** *Red-bellied Woodpecker*, E. Wood Pewee, Willow Flycatcher, Great-crested Flycatcher, E. Kingbird, Whiteeyed Vireo, Philadelphia Vireo, Red-eyed Vireo, Swainson's Thrush, N. Cardinal.

*Kumquat (Citrus japonica) – Long-cultivated exotic citrus species, especially in the southern half of Louisiana. **Observed:** Red-bellied Woodpecker, Cedar Waxwing.

*Satsuma (Citrus unshiu) – Also known as Hardy Mandarin Orange. Long-cultivated exotic species comprised of numerous cultivars or selections. **Observed:** Cedar Waxwing.

Family Smilacaceae

Catbrier/Greenbrier (*Smilax spp.*) – Numerous species native to Louisiana. **Observed:** *Great-crested Flycatcher*, Ash-throated Flycatcher, Blue-headed Vireo, Hermit Thrush, Cedar Waxwing, Green-tailed Towhee, White-throated Sparrow, *Rose-breasted Grosbeak, Summer Tanager*, *Purple Finch*.

Family Solanaceae

Bird Pepper (*Capsicum annuum var. glabriusculum*) – **Observed:** Ash-throated Flycatcher, **Bell's Vireo, Hermit Thrush, Gray Catbird*, N. Mockingbird, *Carolina Chickadee*, N. Cardinal.

"Night-blooming Jasmine" (Cestrum nocturnum) – Observed: N. Mockingbird, N. Cardinal.

Salt-matrimony Vine (*Lycium carolinianum*) – Many additional common names including wolf berry. Habitat preference limited mostly to sandy coastal dune fields and cheniere edges in Louisiana. **Observed:** Great-crested Flycatcher, E. Kingbird, Hermit Thrush, *Cedar Waxwing*, White-crowned Sparrow, Black-headed Grosbeak.

*Nightshades (Solanum spp.) – Many species native and naturalized. Most common Louisiana species include American Black Nightshade (S. americanum) and West Indian Nightshade (S. ptcanthum), both considered native. **Observed:** N. Mockingbird.
